

Enchanted Summer, Solo Exhibition

The inner and summer garden of painter, sculptor and ceramist Bela Silva is revealed through a selection of 25 glazed stoneware sculptures and works on paper that illuminate the space and enchant visitors. A source of vitality and light, Bela Silva's singular universe and palette is rich in colour, motif and artistic expression. In both sculpture and painting, the artist depicts an imaginary world inspired by the mythology and archaeology that fascinate her. She reinterprets the history of art through poetic and unusual compositions, whether collages of birds, snakes, or representations of animals or plants - graphic or free-form - that intertwine to unite in harmony. Humanist and dreamer, Bela Silva's art crosses cultures and takes us on a journey of rejuvenation and rebirth. Lise Coirier


Bela Silva (PT) Artist, Sculptor, Ceramist

Bela Silva was born in Lisbon, Portugal. She lives and works between Brussels, Lisbon and Paris. In Portugal she studied at the School of Fine Arts in Porto and Lisbon, and at Ar.Co. She attended Norwich Fine Arts in the United Kingdom and the Art Institute of Chicago in the United States of America. Her works have been exhibited at the Ann Nathan Gallery, the Rhona Hoffman Gallery, the Lisbon Tile Museum, the Anastácio Gonçalves Museum, the Ajuda National Palace, the Ricardo Espírito Santo Foundation, the Oriente Museum, the National Museum of Art Ancient in Lisbon and the Musée des Arts Décoratifs in Paris. She participated in exhibitions in China, Japan, Brazil, Spain and France and held several ceramic workshops in Japan and Morocco. She attended artist residencies in Kohler, Wisconsin, USA, and Fábrica Bordalo Pinheiro in Caldas da Rainha, Portugal. In 2022 her artworks were shown at Villa Tamaris, la Seyne-sur-Mer within the scope of the saison croisée France - Portugal. More recently, she has exhibited in South Korea and at the Palácio Cadaval in Portugal in 2023, and in the spring of 2024 in a solo exhibition 'Caminho Tropical' at MAC Niteroi in Brazil. Bela Silva has made several. works of public art, in which she integrates her work into the architectural element. Examples are the tile panels for the Alvalade metro station, in Lisbon; the panels for the gardens of the Sakai Cultural Center in Japan and panels for the João de Deus school in the Azores. She has also produced numerous works specially designed for private collectors in Europe and the United States. Bela Silva has collaborated over the years in a variety of projects and partnerships with important international brands such as Hermès, Tiffany & Co, Serax, Viuva Lamego, Bordalo Pinheiro, Vista Alegre and Monoprix. In November 2021 she presented in Paris a hand-painted porcelain collection with the Florentine brand Ginori 1735. Bela Silva's travels are an inexhaustible source of inspiration that allow her to include local history, culture and nature in her creative approach. The artist values the connection between communities incorporating identities, traditional elements into her works that she reinterprets in a contemporary way. In 2025, Bela Silva will publish her monograph with Flammarion and have a solo museum exhibition at the Fondation Calouste Gulbenkian in Lisbon around the Sèvres collection of «Service Buffon», inspired by Buffon's 18thcentury Encyclopaedia of the natural sciences. Spazio Nobile Gallery has represented Bela Silva since 2017.









Tu me fais fondre









Lise Coirier (FR-BE) Art Historian, Art Curator and Publisher, Co-founder of Spazio Nobile

With degrees in management and art history, French-born Lise Coirier has lived and worked in Brussels for 30 years. There, she has run her consulting agency Pro Materia for 20 years, and remains committed to managing projects that she creates from the start. She is Founder and Editor-in-Chief of TL Magazine_True Living of Art & Design, started in 2008, a bilingual (FR/ EN) biannual magazine available in print and online, and dedicated to culture, art and contemporary design. Lise Coirier has also initiated several European projects, such as Human Cities and Glass is Tomorrow. An exhibition curator, she has in addition edited several books, including "Le Guide des Métiers d'art à Bruxelles et environs" (ed. Best of Publishing / Fondation pour les arts, 1998 - 2000), "Design in Belgium - 1945-2000" (ed. Racine, 2002),

Design.be, Belgium is Design (ed. Stichting Kunstboek, 2015 - 2010), monographs of Xavier Lust (ed. Stichting Kunstboek, 2008) and Anne Derasse (ed. Betaplus, 2014), Glass is Tomorrow (ed. Pro Materia / Archibooks, 2015), and more. In 2016, she opened Spazio Nobile Gallery in Brussels, with her partner and husband Gian Giuseppe Simeone, specialised in contemporary applied arts, design and photography.



Gian Giuseppe Simeone (IT-SE) Art Historian & Archæologist, Co-Founder of Spazio Nobile

Gian Giuseppe Simeone is an art historian and archaeologist specialised in the preservation and valorisation of cultural and artistic heritage. Italo-Swedish, based in Brussels since 1979, he works as a consultant on cooperation projects and programmes in the fields of contemporary creation and cultural heritage for the European Commission and other national and international organisations. His consulting firm Culture Lab, launched in 2002, focusses on the design and management of international cooperation projects and programmes in the field of culture, primarily supported by the European Union. Within this context, he has contributed to the implementation of major exhibitions, research programmes and coproductions ventures in disciplines including heritage, music, theatre, the visual arts and design. He has also carried out several

study, assessment and consulting missions in Europe, Africa and the Mediterranean, with the goal of highlighting the importance of culture in the policies of the European Union, and its role in socio-economic development. Gian Giuseppe Simeone is author of several reference works on the study and recognition of the value of European and international culture and heritage. In 2016, he co-founded the Spazio Nobile gallery with Lise Coirier.

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By opening Spazio Nobile in 2016 in the very lively and cosmopolitan district of place Brugmann in Brussels (Belgium), Lise Coirier and Gian Giuseppe Simeone have united their passions for creation and art history. initiating a dialogue between contemporary applied arts, design and photography. Without putting boundaries between disciplines, the visual arts interact with the fine arts. By commissioning a collection of unique pieces, limited editions and installations both experimental and artistic, with a sensitivity particular to everything related to nature and minerality, the gallery organizes each year five exhibitions and several events in art and heritage venues (Maison Louis Carré, Yvelines, France, arch. Alvar Aalto ; Ancienne Nonciature, Grand Sablon, Brussels; Le Châlet de la Forêt, Soignes forest, Belgium, ...). Spazio Nobile also takes part in Belgian and international fairs such as Art Brussels, Luxembourg Art Week, Collectible Design Fair, PAD Paris and PAD London, Design Miami / Basel, Unique Design Shanghai... The gallery represents around thirty emerging and renowned artists and designers on an international scale while promoting high-end craftsmanship and cultures of East and West. Spazio Nobile also curates TLmag_True Living of Art & Design (°2008), the yearly art and design magazine, print and online, sharing its selection and its artistic and cultural commitment to collectible art and design.
